PREREQUISITES:

This course prepares students for entry-level positions as a clinical medical assistant in doctors' offices, clinics or HMOs. Instruction includes medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, injections, phlebotomy, vital signs, basic laboratory procedures, charting and documentation. Integrated throughout the course are career preparation standards, basic academic skills, communication, interpersonal skills, problem solving, workplace safety. technology, and employment readiness

Externships are served at local medical facilities.



Must be 18 years of age with a high school diploma or GED. Must have one year of experience in the health field OR have completed an Administrative Medical Assistant(AMA) class.

Required prior to starting externship:

- TB test and vaccination records
- COVID vaccinations plus Booster
- **Clearance of a Criminal Background Check via DOJ** and FBI
- Clearance of a 10-panel drug screening test.
